## **Growth Item Type Mapping – Updated June 2020**

The original 13 growth item types have been reduced down to 5, as of June 25, 2020. Customers will see the new types as the options in the Type field of a growth item card if their AgilityHealth account was created on or after June 25, 2020. Customers established prior to that date may have the old types as options, may have the new types as options, or may have custom types as options.

Below is a chart describing how the old types were mapped to the new types for customers who chose to opt-in to the new types, as well as a description for each type.

| Agile Enablement                                | Estimating                    | Estimating growth work activities supports practices when the team reviews the theme, feature, epic, story or task and assigns a comparative scaled "measure" based on the effort, complexity, risks, and unknowns, and potentially the value. This allows the team to plan effectively and track their efficiency in planning work overtime.  |
| Culture &<br>Leadership                         | Knowledge Transfer            | Knowledge Transfer growth work activities focus on when subject matter expertise is shared across team members during execution of project activities, or during training activities from shadowing to formal training classes. Where team members can have skill or knowledge growth by being exposed to knowledge transfer, the team's capacity, collaboration, planning and innovation grows building the teams ability to deliver. |



| Culture &<br>Leadership | Leadership/Manage<br>ment | Leadership/Management growth work activities are usually related to impediments that need to be escalated as an Organizational Growth Item. These items usually revolve around Clarity, Consistent Visioning, Resource Commitments, Prioritization and Fire Fighting. These activities may be focused on educating leadership on Agile values, principles and practices. |

| Product & Program       | Planning                  | Planning growth work activities focus on maintaining an environment for the team to optimize it's time during the sprint. Getting the most out of the sprint, managing risk and anticipating future impediments requires planning activities to be implemented to support execution of the sprint and a sustainable velocity for the team.                               |
| Agile Enablement        | Process<br>Improvement    | Process Improvement growth work activities focus on improving processes, activities, and systems to mitigate or eliminate current and future impediments.  |
| Culture &<br>Leadership | Self-Study                | Self-Study growth work activities focus on individual development that can support the team ability to execute or deliver value.   |
| Tech Agility & Tools    | Technical Excellence      | Technical Excellence growth work activities focus on<br>the activities, processes or governance that maintain<br>the integrity or improve the functional use of<br>technology.   |
| Tech Agility & Tools    | Tools   Technology        | Tools   Technology growth work activities focus on acquiring and/or leveraging tools and technology in a way that increase efficiency of the team as it delivers value.  |
| Culture &<br>Leadership | Training                  | Training growth work items focus on developing knowledge or skills necessary to improve the team's ability to innovate, design, build, review and utilize tools and technology to deliver value.   |
